The splendour of the Infinity 501 lies in its endless number of custom options. It's haute couture, yachting-style. By **Andre Frois**

Instantly recognisable by its handsome aluminium streamline form and blitzing speed, the Infinity 501 spearheads the modern evolution of the pleasure craft. Developed by Motion Yachts, a company with a well-publicised obsession with speed and comfort, the Infinity 501, as its name suggests, panders to its master's limitless whims.

Its prospective owner may choose from options like a soft top, hard top or fly-bridge, as well as from a plethora of paints and finishes to coat his new bespoke beauty with. Its aft-deck is a capacious salute to the sun, where one may position parasols in a plenitude of positions across its open space, which can alternatively be installed with a full-width sun awning.

Stairs may be made wider for easier access or slimmer for less visibility. Similar attention is paid to the yacht's deck drains, which are well-hidden for an uncluttered look.

While its deck and gangways may be treated with a special composite that is easily cleaned of marks and stains, the details of its extremely well-equipped kitchen may be discussed with Motion Yacht's adroit interior architects.

Although the yacht already comes with an internal stabilisation system installed for added onboard comfort, one may turn up the gratification with other options like additional stabilisation technology, full indoor air-conditioning, an autopilot, an all-round camera system and a wastewater purification system. Amid the Infinity 501's flurry of options, a feature that one should definitely consider is its fully submersible swimming platform, which expands out to the waterline for the ultimate infinity-edged pool experience. ▣
